One of the church air conditioner units had to be repaired again for a different problem. The pavilion for our 2019 church picnic has been reserved for the last Sunday in July.

Minutes of a Special September 4th Vestry meeting were reviewed. The support structure of the ramp is solid and in good shape. We need to replace the deck and options for different materials are being investigated. The condition of the church flat roof surfaces is being studied.

We are looking into putting up a "Little Free Library" for children's books on our church property.

Maxanna Demko and Robyn Williams were nominated to serve as delegates to the Diocesan Convention on November 9th and 10th. We are entitled to three delegates and three alternates.
