Service Changes During this Lenten Season

Penitential Rite II — During Lent this year, we'll use the Penitential Rite II during our services of Holy Eucharist. The Rite II service uses the same familiar words that we use every week. The only difference is that we'll start off the service each Sunday in Lent with the Confession of Sin - then move into the regular service. We hope that this will reinforce this special time of Lent, as we acknowledge our sins and resolve to change.

No Alleluias during Lent — During Lent, we don't use the word "Alleluia" in our prayers or hymns. On Easter Sunday, we'll fill the service with joy - singing and say this this important word of praise again.

It's Undie-Sunday through Lent!

This year for Lent, we're again collecting new packaged underwear. You may buy new children's, men's, or women's underwear. Place them into the tub in the front of church (by the lectern). 
